Title should be in bold case (font size 14) full names of the authors followed with their affiliation in normal font (font size 12), not exceeding 200 words. The presenting authors name should be bold and marked with asterisk along with e-mail and should be registered for the Conference.

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Poster content should be divided into following sections: Title, Authors, Affiliation, Introduction, Material and Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion and References. Poster should be decent and should not exceed in size from 80×120 cm.

Authors are instructed not to use A4 size papers for their poster presentation.

ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Title should be in bold case (font size 14) full names of the authors followed with their affiliation in normal font (font size 12), not exceeding 200 words

For oral presentation, 10 minutes times will be given followed by 2 minute discussion.
