Brief Report on 6th International Conference on Recent advances in Cardiovascular Sciences, held at DIPSAR, New Delhi

International Academy of Cardiovascular Sciences-India Section successfully organised Sixth International Conference on Recent advances in Cardiovascular Sciences at Delhi Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Research, New Delhi from 31" January-1" February 2014. The conference was attended by more than 300 Delegates. The inauguration was chaired by Nobel Laureate Dr. Ferid Murad and graced by Prof. Ranjit Roy Chaudhury (National Professor of Pharmacology); Dr. Jagdish Prasad (DGHS, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, India); Dr. G. DR RAKESHI KUMAR SHARMA CONFERRED WITH ACHARYA PC RAY MEMORIAL GOLD MEDAL AWARD



Indian Pharmaceutical Association (IPA), Bengal Branch has conferred the Acharya PC Ray Memorial Gold Medal Award to Dr. Rakesh Kumar Sharma, Scientist 'G', INMAS, for his contribution to the pharmaceutical profession.

The Indian Pharmaceutical Association, Bengal Branch annually honor pharmacists in different walks of life including, Scientists, Teachers, Regulators, Hospital Pharmacists, Community Pharmacist, Administrators, to perpetuate in memory of great national figure Acharya PC Ray, the pioneer designer of Pharmaceutical Industry in our country since 1962.

Acharya PC Ray Memorial Gold Medal Award was instituted in the name of Acharya PC Ray who was instrumental in setting up the pharma industry in Bengal in the early 19th century. He established the Bengal Chemical and Pharmaceuticals company as early as 1910 which gave leadership to the Indian medicine sector. Some of the previous awardees are Dr. G B Ramasarma, Prof. Harkishan Singh, Dr. Parvinder Singh,



former chairman and CEO of Ranbaxy Laboratories and Sri Ramanabhai Patel, a distinguished pharmacist of India and founder of Zydus Cadila.

This year, Dr. Rakesh Kumar Sharma won the award for his outstanding contributions to the profession of Pharmacy. The award consists of a gold medal and a citation which were given away during the 52nd National Pharmacy Week observed across the country on November 17, 2013.



Swami Viswamayananda, Secretary, Sargachi Ramakrishna Mission Ashram, Beharampur presented the award to Dr. Sharma at Kolkata, in presence of Dr. CM Ghosh, Director, DTE of Drugs Control, Prof. Dipankar Chakraborty, Vice President, Pharmacy Council of India and Dr. Tulsi Chakrabarti, President, IPA, Bengal Branch. Dr. Sharma delivered Acharya PC Ray Memorial Lecture on 'CBRN Countermeasure: The agenda for Tomorrow"



DST FELLOWSHIPS

SWARNAJAYANTI FELLOWSHIPS 2013-14

Government of India had instituted a scheme titled "SwarnaJayanti Fellowships" to commemorate India's fiftieth year of Independence. Under this scheme a selected number of young scientists, with excellent track record, are provided special assistance and support to enable them to pursue research in frontier areas of science and technology. The fellowship is scientist specific and not institution specific, very selective and has close academic monitoring.

NATURE OF SUPPORT:

The support will cover all the requirements for performing the research and will include a fellowship of Rs. 25,000/- per month for five years. The fellowship will be provided in addition to the salary they draw from their parent Institution. In addition to fellowship, grants for equipments, computational facilities, consumables, contingencies, national and international travel and other special requirements, if any, will be covered based on merit. Scientists selected for the award will be allowed to pursue unfettered research with a freedom and flexibility in terms of expenditure as approved in the research plan. The project should contain innovative research idea and it should have a potential of making impact on R&D in the discipline.

DURATION: The duration of the fellowship will be for a period not exceeding five years.

ELIGIBILITY:

- The applicant should possess Ph.D. in Science/ Engineering/ Medicine.
- Scientists should be active in the frontier area of science and engineering with outstanding

- contributions in the form of research publications and/ or patents, peer recognition from scientific community, awards etc. in his/her area of research.
- The fellowship is open to Indian Nationals residing in India or abroad.
- The scientists from abroad can choose to work at any S&T institution within India. However, he/ she will have to submit a letter from Head of the institution at which they wish to pursue research, stating that administrative and basic infrastructural support to facilitate research will be provided.
- The institute should also undertake financial and other management responsibilities of the project throughout the five year term in case fellowship is awarded to the scientist.

AGE ELIGIBILITY:

The fellowship is open to scientists between 30 to 40 years of age as on December 31, 2013. Applications of candidates who have completed 40 year of age as on or before 31.12.2013 will not be considered.

SELECTION:

The selection procedure will include consideration at various stages. The Department constitutes a Subject Committee which screens applications received and calls the screened in applicants for presentation. The candidates shortlisted after presentation by the Subject Committees will have to make presentation to the National Core Committee of Experts which gives its final recommendations. An empowered Committee of Secretaries will make the final selection based on the recommendation of National Core Committee.

Scientists selected for the award should have accomplished innovative original research in frontier areas of science and technology.

APPLICATION:

Applications for the "SwarnaJayanti Fellowships" are invited from eligible candidates. The candidates may be required to submit further additional information as required and present the project idea before final selection.
